Subject: Orange Alert Phase Notice (HNB District 6 and 7)

As announced by the Government of New Brunswick earlier today, Zone 1 (HNB District 6 and 7) have moved back to the [Orange Alert Phase](#) in the government Recovery Plan, effective midnight on Monday February 8th.

This announcement permits practices in Districts 6 and 7 as well as any other HNB sanctioned teams within this zone. Practices within this zone will be required to follow the Orange Alert Level guidelines in the [Hockey New Brunswick Return to Hockey Guidelines](#).

HNB sanctioned activities remain suspended in Zone 4 (HNB District 1).
