Subject: Orange Alert Phase Notice (HNB District 6 and 7)

As announced by the Government of New Brunswick earlier today, Zone 1 (HNB District 6 and 7) have moved back to the <u>Orange Alert Phase</u> in the government Recovery Plan, effective midnight on Monday February 8th.

This announcements permits practices in Districts 6 and 7 as well as any other HNB sanctioned teams within this zone. Practices within this zone will be required to follow the Orange Alert Level guidelines in the <u>Hockey New Brunswick Return to Hockey</u> <u>Guidelines</u>.

HNB sanctioned activities remain suspended in Zone 4 (HNB District 1).

All other areas of New Brunswick remain in the Orange Alert Phase.
