Since its beginning in 1967, Riverview Minor Hockey has helped over 20,000 Riverview kids participate in Canada's favorite game. Their experiences in the program have been fundamental in teaching them an array of life skills that have served them well as they have grown to be contributing adults in our community and wherever their success has taken them.

The Minor Hockey program in our town is very important to our community. Its success comes from the commitment of the many volunteer organizers, coaches and team managers who understand the importance the Club plays in the youth program. Our slogan, "Providing a Positive Environment for Youth Development through Minor Hockey", truly describes the goal for the program and also the reason why we need fundraising events like the annual golf event to support the Club's programs.

If you are a highly motivated hockey person looking for a position that will challenge you while providing a supportive hockey environment in which to teach, this is the position for you.

This position is responsible for performing a variety of hockey functions. Reporting to the Board of RMHC, the ideal candidate will:

- Create and develop an on-ice program that reflects the vision of RMHC, Hockey New Brunswick, and Hockey Canada for Coaches and Players;
- Participate in the recruiting, managing, motivating, and supporting of coaches in all divisions of RMHC;
- Participate in the technical supervision of teams by helping coaches during their practice sessions and during the course of the games;
- Work with RMHC to monitor the development of the players;
- Work with division coordinators and head coaches (mentor) on their annual and daily plans in terms of levels (AA, A, B, and C) as required;
- Responsible for presenting monthly sessions with coaches on technical aspects;

- Participate in the annual competitive tryout process and aid in the evaluation of players;
- Assist in the balancing of teams in the same level at the recreation level ;
- Help develop and run RMHC player camps to help player development and supplement the salary of the RMHC Technical Director;
- Help in the recruitment and directing of player evaluators;
- Present a report to the executive of RMHC at the monthly executive meetings.

The RMHC Technical Director will be a paid contract position with a base salary and financial incentives for the development and running of RMHC player development camps. Compensation will be dependent on the candidates experience in this type of position. Annual operating budgets will also be developed by RMHC for the clinics, equipment, and other resources needed by the technical director. The position and associated salary will be reviewed by the Board of RMHC on an annual basis.

As a front-line contract employee of RMHC, the ideal candidate must be able to maintain a positive and professional image and must be able to maintain a positive working relationship with the RMHC volunteers and colleagues.
