Proof of COVID-19 Vaccination Update

RIVERVIEW (N.B.) – Effective at 11:59 p.m. on September 21st, 2021, all people aged 12 and up will be required to show their record of immunization or medical exemption certificate and a government issued identification to be able to access indoor Town of Riverview recreation programs and facilities. This follows the recent announcement made by the Government of New Brunswick.

Town staff or designates will verify record of immunization, medical exemption certificate and government-issued identification upon entry to a program or facility. Please allow additional time to enter facilities, as verification is expected to cause some delays. Without the required records, visitors will not be permitted entry to the program or facility.

For reoccurring Town of Riverview programs, verification will be noted on your registration profile so that you will not be required to produce your records more than once. We recommend that you have a copy of your record of immunization so you can easily access it (for example, on your phone or a photocopy in your wallet) in case a provincial inspector requests it.

The Town of Riverview will be in contact with all regular user groups, rentals and associations to review the impacts and expectations of this additional safeguard.
